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							<p>Braintree/Saugus.</p> <p><b>Nicholas Pinyon (Pinion, Pinnion)</b> was baptized 27 Mar 1607 in Warbleton, Sussex and married <b>Elizabeth Starre</b> 1 Oct 1637 in <b>Burwash</b>, Sussex, son of <b>Nicholas Pinyon</b>. (Warning: there are several Nicholas Pinyons baptized about that time in Sussex or Surrey.) Nicholas and his wife, perhaps with family, came on the An Cleve to Massachusetts about 1643. Other members of the Pinyon family remained in England. Nicholas and his wife, Elizabeth, were frequently in trouble with the law and haled before the Essex, MA, court. After the <b>Saugus iron works</b> went bankrupt, they appear to have moved to New Haven, CT. Source: Ancestry.com. Check on Essex Court records.</p> <p><b>John Vinton had a son, John</b>, baptized 9 Apr 1643 in <b>Fletching</b>, Sussex, and married <b>Anne Halfpenny</b>. John also had at least one daughter, <b>Mary</b>, and several more sons: <b>Abraham</b> and <b>Richard</b>. As with the Pinyons, there were a number of <b>John Vintons</b> residing in Sussex, Kent, and Surrey, as well as <b>Tylers</b> and <b>Russells</b>. The Tylers and Russells appear in Herefordshire or Hertfordshire in the late 1500's, about 50 miles from Pontypool, Monmouthshire. <b>Ralph Russell</b> is said to have come from Pontypool to America in 1643, along with James and Henry Leonard.</p> <p><b>Joane, daughter of Richard Russell</b>, bap. 22 Jan 1547, Frant</p> <p><b>John Leonard</b> baptized 29 January 1548, Frant, Sussex, <b>fa.
